The following criteria must be met by the applicant:

- Attends a Florida college
- Has successfully completed at least one developmental math class with an A or B grade
- Have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.5

The following documents must be included in the application packet:

- This scholarship application.
- Up-to-date official college transcript.
- One letter of recommendation from one of your developmental math instructors or math lab learning specialists.
- Typed narrative explaining an innovative method for solving a math problem. Include step by step process and state the objective to be covered. The narrative should be typed double spaced as a Word document in size 12 font, no longer than one page in length. If you are unfamiliar with any math symbol programs, contact your computer lab or math lab instructor for assistance.
- Photograph or photo file in jpg format and signed release at the bottom of this page.
